Nomination (=application) procedure	<ol> <li>The student him/herself needs to register and login at www.erasmus-en.uni-bonn.de → How to apply and fill in the online form.</li> <li>The student prints the online form, signs it and gets it signed by his/her Erasmus coordinator at his/her home university.</li> <li>The signed form needs to be sent (e.g. by scan/fax or by post) by the application deadline to the International Affairs Office of the Department of Law.</li> <li>The receiving department will usually send its decision within four weeks after the above mentioned application deadline.</li> <li>Some departments have additional requirements, documents. They will inform their according cooperation partners about this.</li> <li>Incomplete and late applications will not be processed!</li> </ol>
