Dr. Susan Power, AVCM (Victoria College of Music, London), BA (Print Media) (Cork Institute of Technology), BCL (NUI Galway), PhD (Trinity College Dublin) is a lecturer in law at Griffith College Cork.

She studied Civil Law at NUI Galway, graduating in 2006 with distinction. In 2011, she completed her PhD thesis on *The Limitations of International Humanitarian Law to the Reallocation of Iraqi Oil Resources under the US/UK Transformative Occupation of Iraq* under the supervision of Professors Gernot Biehler and Liz Heffernan at Trinity College Dublin.

She is currently a member of the Dissemination Working Group on International Humanitarian Law, Irish Red Cross. Her research interests include public international law, international humanitarian law and international human rights law. She is currently researching the transition in Libya under the National Transitional Council.
