Professor Peter Malanczuk is C.V. Starr Professor of Law and Co-Director of the Center for Research on Transnational Law at the Peking University School of Transnational Law (Graduate Campus of Peking University in Shenzhen). Currently he teaches courses in Transnational Law, Advanced Transnational Law, International Commercial Arbitration and ADR, and International Economic Law (international trade & investment law).


Before joining the new Peking University School of Transnational Law in 2008, he served as Dean of the School of Law (2004-2007) and Professor (2001-2007) of City University, Hong Kong

Prior to moving to Hong Kong, he was Professor of International Law, Head of Department, and Director of the GLODIS-Institute at the Erasmus University of Rotterdam (1997-2001). From 1990 to 1997, he held the Chair of Public International Law and International Relations at the University of Amsterdam.
