The Contribution of UN Specialized Agencies to the Progressive Development of New Branches of International Law

PROF. DR. CHIA-JUI CHENG
Professor of International Law,
Soochow University

Professor Dr. Cheng graduated from Soochow University School of Law. He obtained his LL.M.s and Diplomas from the Universities of Athens, Poitiers, London, Leiden, and Columbia. He received his LL.D. in International Law from Athens National University, Greece, in 1967 based on the doctoral thesis “The Position of the Individual in International Law”. He rejoined the Law School of Soochow University in 1970, teaching public and private international law.

In 2005, he was elected Secretary-General of the Curatorium and President of the Asian Academy of International Law. In 2013, he was elected Secretary-General of the Curatorium of the Asia Academy of Comparative Law. He also holds many other academic positions in the field of international and comparative law, e.g. Chairman of the Asian Institute of International Air and Space Law, President of the Chinese Association of Civil Air Transport, President of the Chinese Society of Comparative Law, Member of the International Institute of Space Law and Member of the International Academy of Comparative Law.

Professor Dr. Cheng is Editor-in-Chief of Soochow Law Journal. He has published on a wide range of international law topics.
