## **International Environmental Governance: Some Reflections**



PROF. DR. BHARAT H. DESAI Professor of International Law, Jawaharlal Nehru University, India

**Professor Dr. Desai** holds the prestigious *Jawaharlal Nehru Chair in International Environmental Law* and is Chairman of the Centre for International Legal Studies of the School of International Studies at Jawaharlal Nehru University in New Delhi.

He has written and spoken extensively on various fields of International Law, especially in International Environmental Law. His recent publications include International Environmental Governance: Toward UNEPO (Brill Nijhoff, 2014), Implementation of the Convention on Biological Diversity: A Retrospective Analysis in the HKH Countries - with co-authors (ICIMOD, 2011) and Multilateral Environmental Agreements: Legal Status of the Secretariats (CUP, 2010). He serves as an Associate Editor of the Yearbook of International Environmental Law (OUP), a Governing Board member of the IUCN Academy of Environmental Law (Ottawa, Canada) as well as Chairman of the Centre for Advanced Study on Courts & Tribunals (Amritsar, India).

Professor Desai's pioneering work on "UNEP: A Global Environmental Authority?" (36 *Environmental Policy & Law* 137 (2006)) and proposal to 'upgrade' UNEP into a UN specialized agency was referred to the President of the United Nations General Assembly as well as to the United Nations Secretary-General's High-Level Panel on System-wide Coherence and served as an input for the Rio+20 Summit consideration of 'institutional framework for sustainable development' in July 2012.
