International Law and the Climate Negotiations

Christoph Schwarte is the executive director of Legal Response Initiative (LRI) – a London-based charity that provides free legal advice to poor and climate vulnerable developing countries and NGOs.

He was a member of the International Law Association's Committee that developed legal principles related to climate change, and Mr Schwarte has been actively involved in the international climate negotiations for many years.

Before joining LRI he worked at the Foundation for International Environmental Law and Development, as well as the International Institute for Environment and Development.

Between 1998 and 2004 he was an Associate Officer (P-2) at the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea in Hamburg. He holds an LL.M. degree from the School of Oriental and African Studies, University of London, and qualified to practice at the German bar in 1997.
