Sir Michael Wood is a Senior Fellow of the Lauterpacht Centre for International Law, University of Cambridge. He is a barrister at 20 Essex Street, London, where he practices in the field of public international law. He was Legal Adviser to the UK's Foreign and Commonwealth Office between 1999 and 2006, having joined as an Assistant Legal Adviser in 1970.

Sir Michael is one of the world's leading international lawyers who regularly appears before the International Court of Justice, European Court of Justice, European Court of Human Rights, International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea, international arbitral tribunals and the English courts.

He has been a Member of the International Law Commission since 2008 and is currently Special Rapporteur for the topic "Identification of Customary International Law." FORTHCOMING LECTURES:
